## **Key Dates**

- 1828 the Dutch claimed the western half of the island as part of the Dutch East Indies
- 1884 the German Empire took possession of the north east quarter of the island
- 6 November, 1884 a British protectorate was proclaimed over the southern coast (Papua) of the island British New Guinea
- 1899 the German Imperial Government took control of the north east quarter German New Guinea
- 1 September, 1906 British New Guinea was renamed the Territory of Papua and placed under Australian Commonwealth control
- 1 September, 1914 Australian forces occupied German New Guinea in WW1 and it remained under Australian military rule until 1921
- 17 December, 1920 Post WW1 German New Guinea became the Territory of New Guinea administered by Australia under a League of Nations mandate
- March, 1942 During WW2 Australia (ANGAU) assumed military control of Papua and New Guinea
- October, 1945 Post WW2, Australian civil administration of each of the Territories of Papua and New Guinea commenced
- 1 May 1963 Administration of Western New Guinea transferred to the Republic of Indonesia and renamed Irian Jaya
- 1 July, 1971 Territory of Papua and New Guinea renamed Papua New Guinea
- 1 December, 1973 Papua New Guinea became self-governing
- 16 September, 1975 Papua New Guinea became an independent nation

The information reported in each year book changed over time, and only years which have published data are listed

Not reported means that the data was not reported specifically in the Year Books of Australia
